

Presentation of Emergency Disaster Relief Assistance for People Affected by the Sulawesi Earthquake and Tsunami in Indonesia

The Foundation wishes to express our sincere condolences to the families of those who lost their lives in the earthquake and tsunami that occurred in Sulawesi, Indonesia on September 28 (Friday), and our heartfelt sympathies to all those affected by the disaster.
