Major damage has been caused by successive river flooding due to the unprecedented levels of torrential rain in the Kyushu region from July 4 onwards.

The AEON 1% Club Foundation wishes to express our sincere condolences for the lives lost in this disaster, and we extend our deepest sympathies to all survivors who have suffered from the effects of the flooding.

As emergency relief funds for those affected by the disaster, the Foundation will make donations of 10 million yen to Kumamoto Prefectural Government, and 5 million yen to Oita Prefectural Government, respectively.

In the affected regions, there are still many missing persons whose safety remains unconfirmed, and the risk of new torrential rainfall and flooding is feared. In addition to offering our heartfelt sympathies, it is the Foundation's fervent hope that residents of the region will be spared of any further damage.
