(Honorable Mention)"

We hereby announce that the AEON 1% Club Foundation has been awarded the "Medal with Dark Blue Ribbon" for our donation to "Emergency Relief for Damages Caused by Torrential Rain due to Typhoon Faxai in September 2019".

The "Medal with Dark Blue Ribbon" is an honor awarded by the Japanese government to individuals, corporations or organizations that have contributed private assets for public benefit and have achieved outstanding results. On October 8 (Thu.), the Foundation's chairman, Hiroshi Yokoo, received notice of an Honorable Mention awarded by the Cabinet Office, from Mr. Toshiharu Ishiwata, Director of Chiba Prefecture's Disaster Prevention and Crisis Management Department, at Chiba Prefectural Office.

The Foundation has carried out various support activities for emergencies and disasters, both domestically and internationally with a focus on Asian nations, since our establishment in 1989. In addition to providing aid to Chiba, Miyagi, Fukushima, Tochigi, Ibaraki, and Nagano Prefectures, all of which were seriously affected by damage caused by Typhoon Faxai and Hagibis last year, we also gave financial support to Kumamoto and Oita Prefectures this year, as relief for the "Torrential Rain of July 2020". The Foundation wishes to express our sincere hope that normal daily life can resume in the disaster-affected regions as soon as possible, and will continue to strive in our efforts to provide swift assistance for emergencies and disasters.
