Standing Together with Everyone who Wishes to See Shuri Castle Again "AEON Shuri Castle Restoration Support Project" Expanding Our Initiatives, For Okinawa's Future

In November 2019, AEON launched the "AEON Shuri Castle Restoration Support Project" in response to the major damage caused to Shuri Castle by a large-scale fire that occurred before dawn on October 31, 2019. This project, which now reaches the end of its second year, is motivated by our desire to provide continuous support for the restoration of cultural assets to be passed down to the next generation.

Today, the AEON 1% Club Foundation presented a donation of 100 million yen to Okinawa Prefectural Government in order to assist with the restoration of the castle,

following on from last year. This donation is the second-year portion of our announced plan to donate 500 million yen over a five-year period, and is due to be utilized for initiatives aimed at restoration, in connection with the inheritance of Okinawan traditions and culture.

Since the launch of the project, donations from across Japan have reached a total of 87,854,222 yen*1, which will be donated to the Okinawa Churashima Foundation's "Shuri Castle Fund", and used to support the reconstruction of the castle. In addition, we are expanding our initiatives to include the "Okinawa Specialty Products Fair"*2, held by various member companies of the AEON Group, as well as promotion of use of the Shuri Castle WAON Card, and sightseeing tours to experience Okinawan attractions, in solidarity with everyone who wishes to see the castle restored. Furthermore, the project will be expanded to the entire domestic AEON Group from November 1, and fundraising activities will be implemented nationwide.

AEON will continue to coordinate with the regional population in the aim of supporting the inheritance of Okinawan traditions and culture.



■ 2nd "Shuri Castle Panel Exhibition" & "Shuri Castle Outline Art & Coloring-in Exhibition"

This exhibition at an AEON Ryukyu store, in succession to last year's event, is held in cooperation with the Okinawa Churashima Foundation. ■ For Shuri Castle of 100 Years From Now: "Foster an Inumaki Seedling Project"

The AEON Environmental Foundation*4 launched the "Foster a Seedling Project" to cultivate Inumaki pine trees, to be used as essential timber in the reconstruction work, as a cooperative initiative with regional "foster parents" to support the restoration of Shuri Castle. Distribution of the Inumaki pine seedlings was completed in December 2020, and the seedlings have already been cultivated by their "foster parents" for a period of approximately one year. These seedlings will be planted by the AEON Environmental Foundation and AEON Ryukyu Co., Ltd., with the cooperation of the Friends of Shuri Castle Park Association, so that the project will continue to foster the growth of new greenery.

Tree-Planting Location: Planned for vicinity of Benoki Dam, Kunigami, Okinawa Tree-Planting Period: From January 2022 (Provisional)
